 - Shared drive and folders for things like disbursement files
 - Integration of PowerFaids and Jenzabar with FA view in JZ for Student Accounts team
 - Refund process checked by both offices
 - Quarterly cross-trainings
 - Annual review of process improvement

Eyes on a refund

- In addition to regular census, audits, safenets...
- When credit balance occurs, Student Accounts looks through each one and highlights any that seem out of the norm
- Reviewed by FA to ensure Title IV and institutional funding is accurate
- ❖ Prevents over-award of <u>institutional</u> funding

Areas of heavy collaboration

- Information sharing
 - Satisfactory Academic Progress(SAP)
 - Account holds and late fees
 - * Return to Title IV (R2T4)
- Co-working
 - Financial clearing for enrollment
 - "Swapping" of funds
 - Veteran benefits
 - Outside scholarships and thirdparty billing

- Undergraduate Admissions
 - bi-monthly meetings of Admission, Financial Aid and Enrollment Services
 - Shared operational calendar for application, admission, and FA packaging timelines
 - Enrollment Leadership Team (Admissions, Financial Aid, Enrollment Services, Communications)
 - Data sharing across systems (Slate/Banner)soon to be SLATE/PowerFaids/WorkDay)
